



Louisiana Children's Trust Fund Board Seeks New Executive Director

The Louisiana Children's Trust Fund Board is seeking a self-motivated, dynamic, proven, visionary leader to facilitate child abuse and neglect prevention programs for the State of Louisiana as Executive Director of the Louisiana Children's Trust Fund.

Qualifications:

The position requires that a candidate possess a baccalaureate degree plus three to five years of professional experience in social work, education, or youth services programming; hospital or institution administration; or any business management or public administration experience. Candidates with child abuse and neglect prevention experience are preferred. Candidates shall also possess knowledge of contracts, contract monitoring, staff development, policy development, event planning and research analysis. A master's degree may be substituted for 2 years of the required experience. The successful candidate must have knowledge of best practices in child abuse and neglect prevention and demonstrate excellent administrative skills, including fiscal and programmatic management and oversight of grant funding. The successful candidate must also be a leader in advocacy and outreach, and be able to communicate, and partner with state agencies, a governing board, and community members to implement a comprehensive child abuse and neglect prevention programs for Louisiana. Candidates must be able to travel throughout the state of Louisiana and any required out-of-state grant meetings.

Salary and Benefits:

Salary will be based on experience. The State of Louisiana provides benefits and a reasonable leave policy and is an Equal Opportunity (EEO) Employer. This is an unclassified, full-time position based in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.
