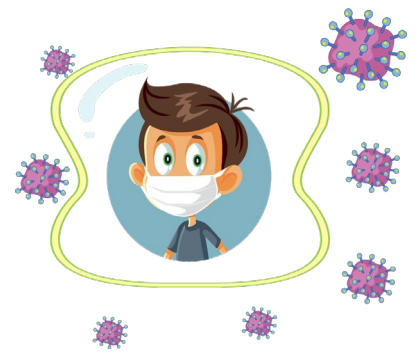


From Covid Chaos to Caring for Our Children 2021 Legislative Update & Virtual Roadshow
